5. METHODS OF COMPETITION

- (Respectively) Single elimination tournament system for each weight category.
(Cadet I Category Mixed Gender)
- Mixed competition between Koreans and Foreigners.
- Competitors should bring their own Mandatory Safety Equipment.
- Coach shall be allocated with one (1) appeal to request an instant video replay request per once until the quarterfinals and once from the semi-finals to the finals.
- The best of three (3) system. (Excluding color belts)
- All competitors must wear WT or KTA officially-approved Taekwondo uniform(Dobok).
 - Non-official uniforms are allowed.
 - Club names and affiliated teams are allowed on the uniform.
- **KPNP(K2)** Protector and Scoring System (PSS) will be used in Kyorugi competition. The Organizing Committee will provide **KPNP(K2)** Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.
 - No PSS is used in B League. (No Instant Video Replay)
- When the number of contestants in a category or weight class is less than four(4), they will be combined with the next higher weight class.
- ※ If there are 2 contestants in the Under 9 competitions -23kg class and 3 constestants in the -25kg class, they will be combined. (Up to two weight classes)
 - The weigh-in will be conducted based on the initially registered weight class.
 - If there are less than four(4) participants due to disqualification, failure to show at weigh-in, or being unable to participate due to merged weight classes, only medals will be awarded. (no certificates will be given, and the results will not be considered official)
 - The cases of integrated weight class are accepted as an official result.

6. COMPETITION RULES

- WT Competition Rules shall be applied(January 1, 2026.)

7. DURATION OF COMPETITION

- Cadet I & II : 1 minute x 3 rounds (30 seconds break time)
- Cadet III : 1 minute 30 seconds x 3 rounds (30 seconds break time)
- Junior I & II : 1 minute 30 seconds x 3 rounds (30 seconds break time)

8. WEIGH-IN

- All competitors should bring their AD cards when they weigh-in, otherwise will be disqualified.
- **The Weigh-in will be conducted twice a day, and an athlete may only participate in one weigh-in session.**
- Weigh-in of the Competitors shall be completed on the previous day of the pertinent competition. (Place will be noticed later)
- Weigh-in shall be conducted once, however, in case of under or exceeding, one more chance will be given within the weigh-in time. (approximately two hours)
- The competitors participating in Cadet(I , II , III) and Junior(I , II) categories must be weighed with underwear(s) on and 100 grams will be allowed to compensate.

9. OTHERS

- All officials including Head and coaches of each team must complete the registration as officials and hold an AD card to enter the stadium.
- If the competitor is called 3 times 30 minutes before the start of the game and do not participate after declaring the participation, the competitor will be disqualified.
- Matters not specified in the regulation shall be decided after deliberation by the Organizing Committee of Chuncheon Leisure·Taekwondo.
- In cases of clear system errors(such as changes in participant categories or missing participants), the athlete will be added to the last match number of their category.
- It may be subject to change at the discretion of the TD during the head of team meeting.

- Can contain 1 substitute
- A team of three players will win the presiding judge's position during the game, and if an injured player occurs, the game will be terminated.
- Athletes participating in the individual event and the 3–member team sparring event (two categories) must compete under the same affiliated team.

Example:

Allowed: Individual event (Chuncheon A) and 3–person team event (Chuncheon A) with the same affiliation.

Not allowed: Individual event (Chuncheon A) and 3–person team event (Chuncheon B) with different affiliations.

- Mixed competition between Koreans and Foreigners.
- Protector and Scoring System (PSS) will be used in Kyorugi competition.
The Organizing Committee will provide Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.
- Each team player shall submit a list of players to the competition's progressive headquarters 30 minutes before the start of the competition.
 - If a participant is not finally confirmed at the inspection table even after the third call, they will be disqualified.
- The list of participants shall consist of three full-time players in each game, and may freely participate by replacing the captain and the substitute.

4. COMPETITION RULES

- Round 1 : Regardless of weight class, three athletes must compete in the order listed on the roster, each engaging in a one-minute match.
- Round 2 : Athletes may be substituted freely upon the signal from the coach or director. However, a substitution can only occur after the athlete has completed three attacking actions, and both teams cannot substitute players simultaneously.
- If any of the three designated athletes does not participate in Round 2, the team will be disqualified and declared the loser.
- **Substitution Rules**
 - The substitute athlete must wait outside the boundary line (at the coaching area) while the coach or director verbally announces "Blue, Red Substitution" and raises a flag toward the sky. The referee will immediately declare "Break" and "Substitution," after which the substitution is completed by a hand touch at the boundary line. The substitute then enters the competition area, and the referee announces "Continue" to resume the match.
 - Both teams cannot substitute players at the same time.
 - If an athlete becomes "incapacitated" during Round 1, the opponent responsible for causing the incapacitation will be awarded 10 points, and the incapacitated athlete will be substituted so the next athlete can continue the match. If a second athlete from the same team becomes incapacitated, that team will be declared the loser, and the match will end.
 - If an athlete becomes "incapacitated" during Round 2, their team will be declared the loser, and the referee will end the match by discretionary decision.
 - During Round 2, an athlete is unable to continue for more than 30 seconds, they must be substituted. (Once an appropriate exchange of offensive and defensive actions has taken place, the substituted athlete may re-enter.) If the substitution does not occur within 30 seconds, the referee will issue a penalty and initiate the substitution process. The coaching staff must promptly prepare the substitute for the exchange.
- Win by point gap: There is no upper limit to the score or Win by point-gap.
- Win by referee's punitive declaration : If a contestant accumulated (20) "Gam-jeom" regardless of the round, will be declared the loser.

- Golden Point Round: Conducted as a single one-minute round. The first athlete to score or force their opponent to receive two penalties will win the match. If the match remains tied, the winner will be decided by superiority judgment.

5. DURATION OF COMPETITION : 3 minutes x 2 rounds (1 minute break time)

- If the match ends in a tie, there will be a 30 second break, followed by a one-minute Golden Point round between one representative athlete from each team.

6. OTHERS

- All officials including Head and coaches of each team must complete the registration as officials and hold an AD card to enter the stadium.
- If the competitor is called 3 times 30 minutes before the start of the game and do not participate after declaring the participation, the competitor will be disqualified.
- Matters not specified in the regulation shall be decided after deliberation by the Organizing Committee of Chuncheon Leisure-Taekwondo.
- In cases of clear system errors(such as changes in participant categories or missing participants), the athlete will be added to the last match number of their category.
- It may be subject to change at the discretion of the TD during the head of team meeting.

- Break time of Recognized Poomsae : within 30sec to 60sec / Exceeding the time, score deduction shall be applied.

5. DETAILS OF EACH COMPETITIONS

A. Recognized Poomsae(Indiv./Pair/Team)

1) Methods Of Competition

- Single elimination tournament System shall be applied to the Poomsae Competition. (1 by 1)
- In case of an insufficient number of Competitors in each category, a demonstration competition shall be carried out.
- All competitors must wear WT or KTA officially-approved Taekwondo uniform(Dobok).
 - Non-official uniforms are allowed.
 - Club names and affiliated teams are allowed on the uniform.
- For Overall awards, results of each competition count as 1 gold medal for individual division and 3 gold medals for Team division.

2) The competition area for Recognized Poomsae : 10m×10m

3) Scoring of Recognized Poomsae

- Scoring shall be made in accordance with the rules of the KTA. (2026)
- Composition of refereeing official shall be a five-judge system.

6. COMPULSORY POOMSAE

- It is compulsory to perform two types of Poomsae in each entry.
- (A League) The Compulsory Poomsae will be randomly selected during the Head of Team Meeting via an electronic drawing
- (B League) Compulsory Poomsae shall be selected through Organizing Committee.
- (Mixed League) The Compulsory Poomsae will be randomly selected during the Head of Team Meeting via an electronic drawing

B. Methods of Competition

- All the Gyeokpa objects are provided by OC and the same Gyeokpa objects are used for both preliminaries and finals use.
- Cut-off System shall be applied to the Gyeokpa Competition.
- If there are no more than three participants in each category, it shall be conducted in conjunction with other category.

C. Scoring(Jumeok & Sonnal Gyeokpa)

- After the 1 attempt, place of competitor shall be determined by the result of the numbers of broken objects.
- In case of a tied score, higher place shall be determined to the competitor with the large number of objects applied to break.
- If number of applied objects are still tied, higher place shall be determined to the one who weighs less.

6. OTHERS

- All officials including Head and coaches of each team must complete the registration as officials and hold an AD card to enter the stadium.
- If the competitor is called 3 times 30 minutes before the start of the game and do not participate after declaring the participation, the competitor will be disqualified.
